## ***One Joint Campaign with Two Funds***

We've setup two separate funds for two very distinct purposes. It's important that both be funded, so we strongly encourage you to give to both The Vallamont Fund and the Chi Phi Leadership Fund.

### **The Vallamont Fund: \$350,000 goal**

Contributions to this fund will be used to bring Vallamont up to and beyond its previous living standard, building on the significant work the college has done to improve safety, kitchen facilities, and other miscellaneous improvements. Our goals include:

- Furnishing of 1st Floor – Spring 2018
- Rock Room, TV Room, Red Room, and other basement area repairs and upgrades - Summer 2018
- Landscaping front entrance – Summer 2018
- Kitchen start-up expenses – Fall 2018
- Future improvements and repairs - 2019 and 2020

Funds contributed to the Vallamont Fund will be given directly to the Rho Chapter Association and will not be tax deductible.

### **Chi Phi Leadership Fund: \$100,000 goal**

These gifts to Lafayette will support Rho Chapter student awards and educational programs. Gifts to the Chi Phi Leadership Fund will be primarily directed to Chi Phi students in the following ways:

- On-campus training in leadership development, risk management, hazing prevention, and other relevant programs
- Opportunities to strengthen and enrich the Greek community.
- Merit-based awards for Chi Phi Brothers, e.g., Most Improved GPA
- Values-based awards including the Spirit of Brian Keller True Gentlemen Award

Funds donated to the Chi Phi Leadership Plan are gifts to Lafayette College and qualify as 501(c)(3) tax deductible\* gifts.

***Total Three Year Campaign Goal: \$450,000***

Contributions to either fund can be a one-time contribution or can be pledged over three years.

For full details on how to pledge your support and contribute, please refer to the Pledge Planning Guide. We ask that you first determine your per year pledge and then determine the percent which you are comfortable contributing to each fund for each of the next 3 years. Confirm your commitment by completing and returning the fund specific forms, one to Rho the other to Lafayette.

The Rho Chapter will recognize contributors based on their total commitment to this campaign, combining the gifts made to Chi Phi and to Lafayette. Gifts made to Lafayette will be recognized in their Summary of Giving at the appropriate level based on the gift to the Chi Phi Leadership fund.
